Nature's *Rugged* Heart Meets Sublime *Elegance*

n the 1860s, Park City, Utah was known for its burgeoning silver mines. Hopeful crowds of prospectors from across the United States came to the west to collect the mineral in droves, building campsite settlements around the surrounding mountains. The town thrived with wealth until the 1950s, when the cost of silver dropped significantly — along with the town's population — but the residents of Park City have always been entrepreneurial, and the area began reviving itself as a means to survive. By 1963, the first ski resort had opened on 10,000 acres, and tourism flourished as Park City began expanding as a resort town into the 1980s and beyond.

Park City has grown into one of the most affluent resort towns in the United States. In 2002, it rose to fame with the Winter Olympic Games and has since thrived as a lively community. Many notable Olympic medalists have called Park City home, including Stein Eriksen, Joss Christensen, Bill Demong, Ted Ligety, Jimmy Shea, Sage Kotsenburg, Joe Pack, and many others who specialize in winter sports such as speed skating, snowboarding, skeleton, bob sledding and various types of skiing.



Situated around 35 minutes east of Salt Lake City, Park City lies in the snow-capped Wasatch Range, which is recognized for its top-tier ski resorts, outdoor activities, shopping and hundreds of dining options. Filled with a rich history, its colourful Main Street includes 64 Victorian buildings catalogued in the National Register of Historic Places. Town guests can visit in its mine buildings, mine shafts, hoists and water towers, while learning about the town's unique heritage.

Astone's throw away is Promontory Club, a close-knit community like no other - a spectacular mountain retreat all about luxury. Promontory is a compelling, unique offering and boasts only the best summer and winter activities to its members and residents. Situated on 6,400 acres of land between 6,500 to 7,400 feet above sea level, Promontory brings families together, celebrating a lifestyle grounded in the outdoors.

When booking a treatment at the Promontory Spa, guests are invited to take advantage of the eucalyptus infused steam room, indoor and outdoor jacuzzi hot tubs, and the men's and women's locker rooms fully stocked with everything you might need.

Since 2001, Promontory, which spans over 10 square miles, has invested more than \$400 million in developing this spectacular multi-generational second home community including a vast array of sophisticated, award-winning amenities. Developer F. Francis Najafi, the founder of Pivotal Group, saw the potential for a timeless club that didn't quite fit into a traditional ranch or mountain country club narrative. Francis bought the parcel of land which had been used for grazing sheep, and worked with the county to begin developing his own vision.

"We saw many luxury communities that were heavily invested in golf, but if you had family with different age groups who weren't golfers, they found they didn't have a lot to do," he continues. 

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One of the most striking things about Promontory is its multi-generational membership, where members can include their parents, their children, adult children, spouses and grandchildren as members. "It makes it easy to have your family come and enjoy all the amenities **Promontory has** to offer," says Robin. Situated in raw and real nature, 60 percent of Promontory's land is purely dedicated open space, and is protected under the stewardship of Promontory's Conservancy. Integrated into the Home Owners' Association, the Conservancy ensures protective policies are put in place regarding the property's internal trail system and neighborhood parks.

"We do everything we can so the wildlife natural to this area can move freely through our property," Robin says, adding that there aren't any fences on the homes in Promontory. The Conservancy is dedicated to preserving habitat for elk and deer, and members regularly spot porcupines, bunnies, coyotes and even cougars. Working in connection with Promontory's Conservancy, the Utah Department of Natural Resources tracks populations and ensures that native species have enough to eat and move around. "We're dedicated to the natural wildlife. It's a big draw to our community and it's one thing all of our residents love."

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



The award-winning architecture was inspired by Park City's rich history in silver mining and features: a fireside lobby with board games, an art silo studio, billiards & retro arcade games, a 50-seat movie theatre, a two-lane bowling alley, an indoor basketball arena, the Mercantile stocked with local gourmet snacks, wines, and sundries, plus a 500-seat outdoor amphitheater with tiered lawn

Today, Promontory is a collection of 25 different neighborhoods. Residents and investors can buy their own property seamlessly with the new-construction division, Promontory Homes, which has around six neighborhoods that are easy for remote buyers to invest in, including floor plans and unique customizations. The market is segmented with villas starting at \$1.5 million. The remainder of offerings are related to custom estate homes.



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
The elevation at Promontory allows members to enjoy a panoramic vista of white caps from north to south as they drive the slight incline from their homes down to the main road connecting them to Park City and through the undulating foothills to Salt Lake City and the airport.
